Kandiyohi County, January 4, 2021 – The Kandiyohi County Area Family YMCA will offer its upcoming Youth Basketball Season for kids ages 3 to 4th Grade. The program focuses on skill development, rules of the game, sportmanship, character development and fun. Everybody plays and everybody wins.

The season will run from January 11 through February 18. Jerseys will be available for purchase for \$10.00. Each player must have the jersey to play. Lil' Basketball for 3-5 year olds and Kindergarten Basketball will be Thursdays only from 4:45-5:20 pm. Grades 1-4 meet on Mondays and Thursdays. 1st-2nd grades meet from 5:30-6:25 pm and 3rd & 4th grades meet from 6:35-7:30 pm.

Mat Snider, Program Director, states, "Our program encourages kids to play hard, to work with their teammates, to be good sports, and to enjoy the game."

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, enrollment is limited to 18 youth per age group. One parent per participant is allowed for ages 3 through 2nd grade. No spectators are allowed for grades 3-4. Equipment is cleaned between sessions. Masks covering the mouth and nose and wellness check on entering facility are required for all participants, coaches, spectators and staff. The first few practices will be skills only, but games will resume once executive orders allow.
